Types of Folds

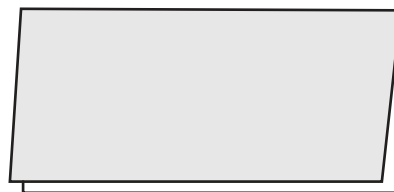
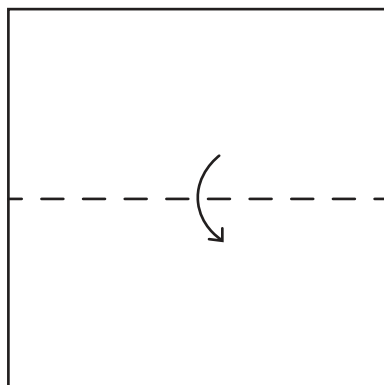
1. Valley Fold

A valley fold is the most basic origami fold, where you fold the paper towards you.



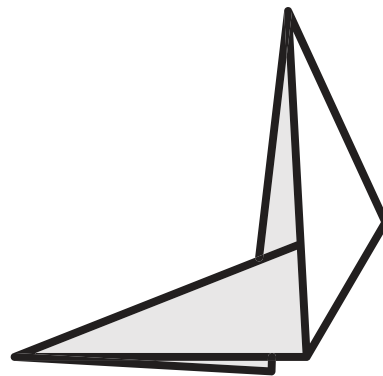
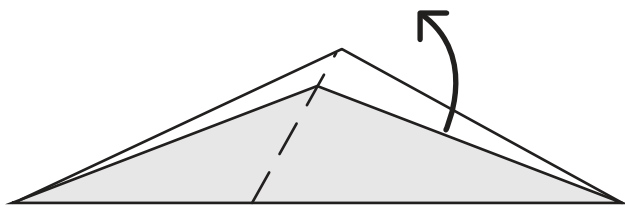
2. Mountain Fold

The mountain fold is the opposite of the valley fold. You fold the paper away from you.



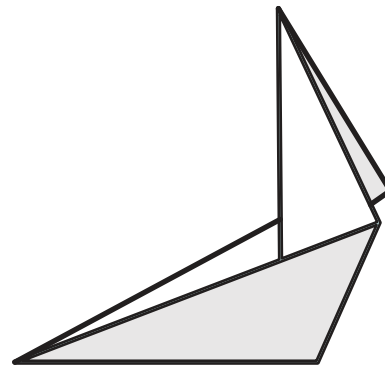
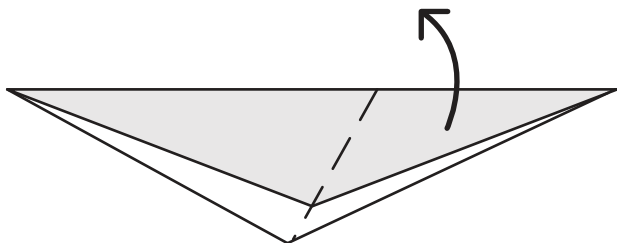
3. Inside Reverse Fold

An inside reverse fold is used to fold a part of the paper inside itself to create specific shapes or structures within the model.



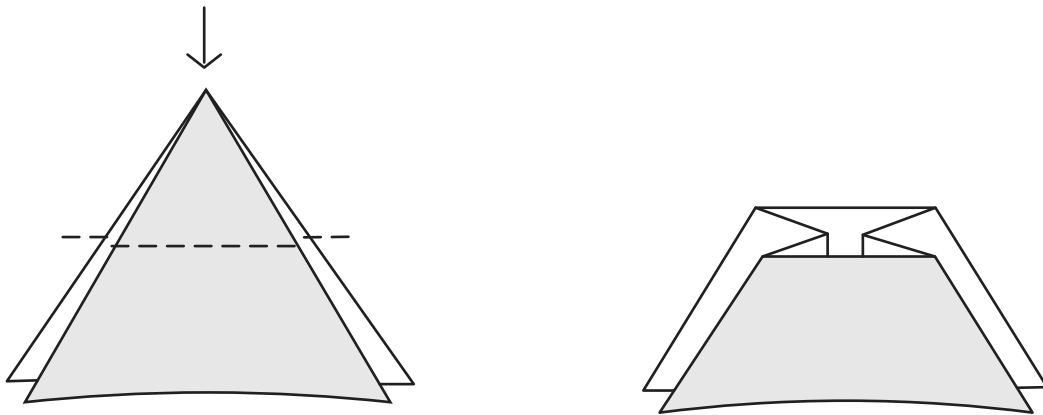
4. Outside Reverse Fold

An outside reverse fold is similar to the inside reverse fold, but the folded section is on the outside of the model.



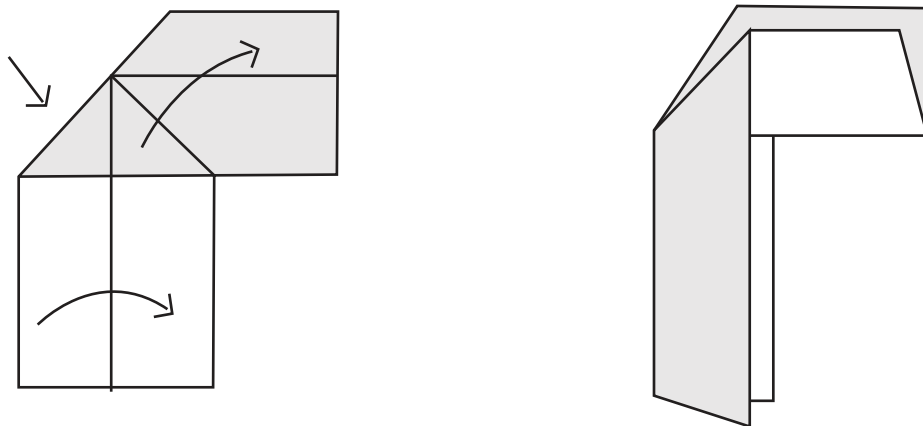
5. Sink Fold

A sink fold is a technique that involves opening a flap of paper, and then folding it inward, effectively "sinking" it into the model's structure.



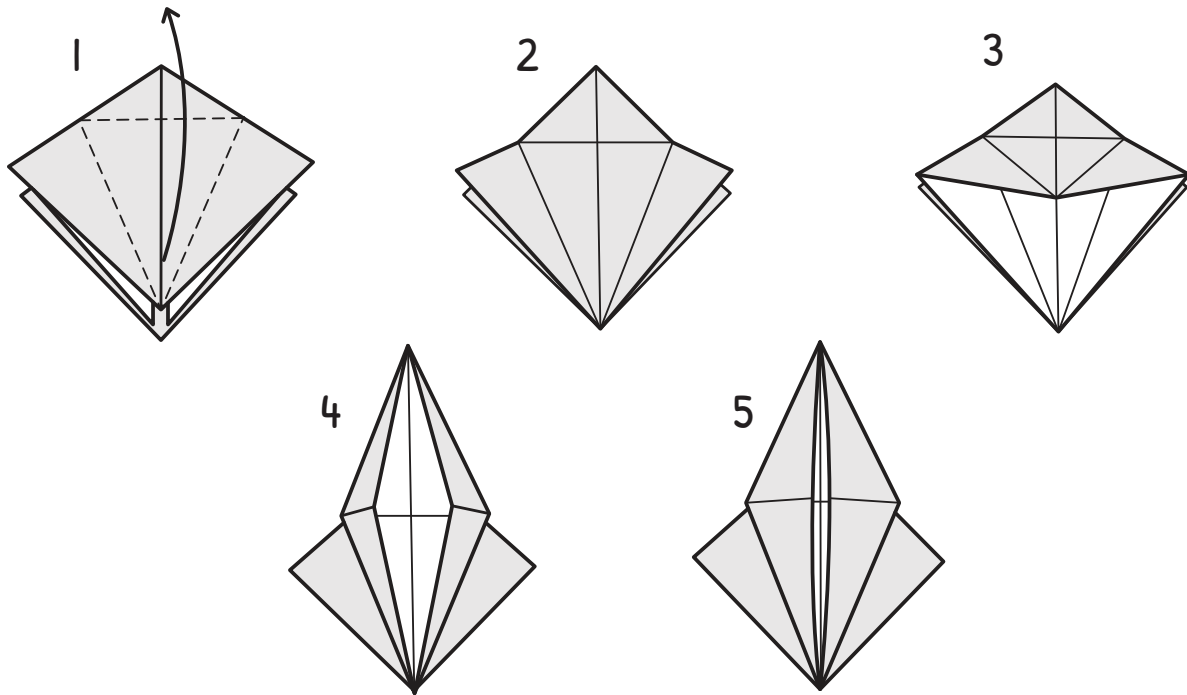
6. Swivel Fold

This fold is used to create a rotating or swiveling element in the origami model, often seen in designs like pinwheels.



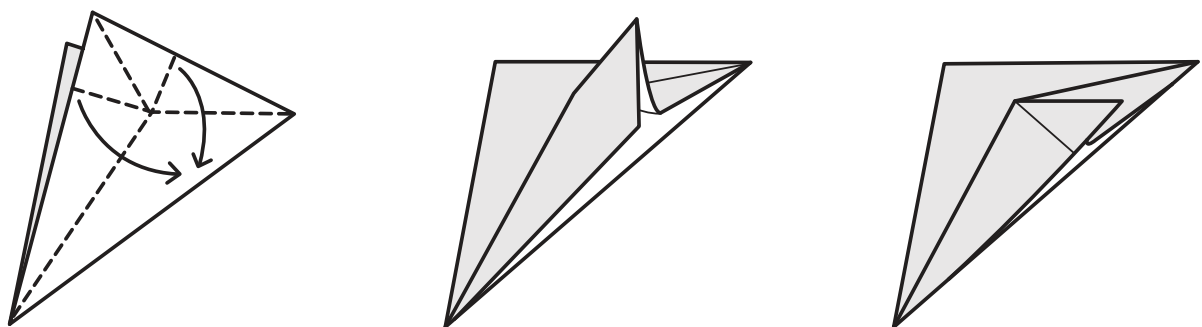
7. Petal Fold

The petal fold is used to create flower-like structures by folding a section of the paper to resemble a petal.



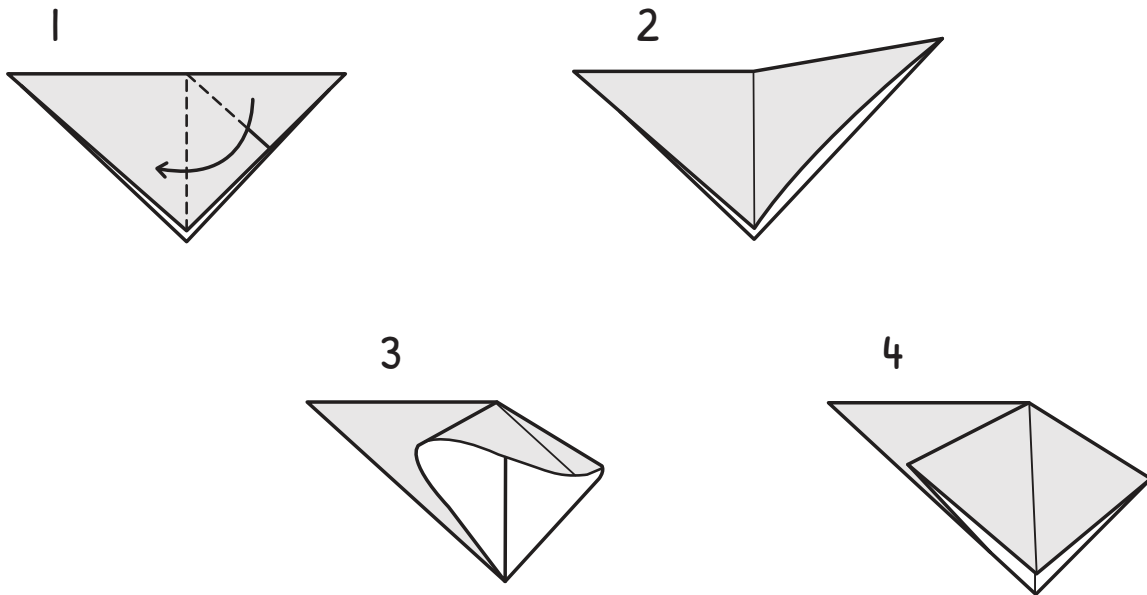
8. Rabbit Ear Fold

The rabbit ear fold is a common fold used to create pointed or triangular shapes in origami models.



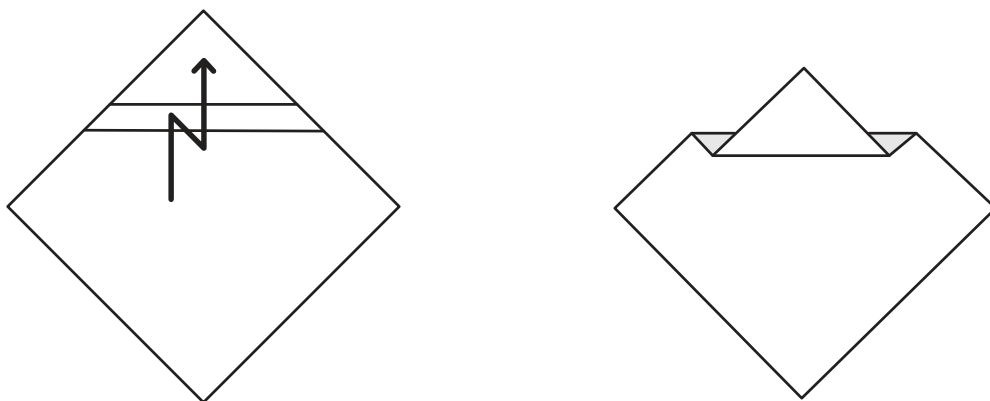
9. Squash Fold

The squash fold is a common origami fold used to flatten or "squash" a part of the paper model, often to create a specific shape or to add dimension.

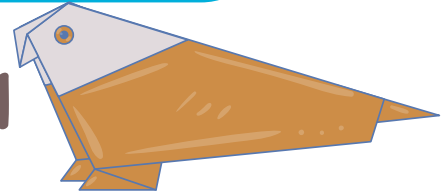

A pleat fold in origami is a technique that involves creating a series of parallel accordion-like folds in the paper.

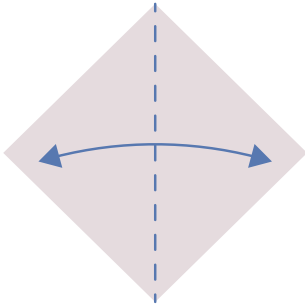
